



## **GETTING TO UKHSA PORTON**

Porton Down is approximately 8 miles from Salisbury and transport will be required, whether by taxi or by one's own car. There is a limited bus service.

### **Road**

The Winterslow Road across the MOD Ranges has been upgraded and is suggested to be the primary route of access for visitors.

Visitors arriving from the North and East are advised to use the M3 or A34, then the A30 through Stockbridge or the A303/A343 towards Salisbury. Turn right at the traffic lights as signposted. Visitors from the West and from Salisbury, take the A338 and turn right through Porton Village and under the railway arch.

UKHSA (previously known as PHE) is well signposted from the highway. Please Note Some 'Sat-Nav' system send people through Idminton Village to the neighbouring Dstl establishment when using the postcode, therefore please use 'Manor Farm Road' as your destination, or follow the roadsigns from the A30/A338.

### **Air**

The site at Porton Down is less than 2 hours drive from Heathrow, Gatwick and Bristol airports, about 45 minutes from Southampton airport, and 1 hour from Bournemouth airport.

### **Rail**

Andover railway station is about 30 minutes from UKHSA Porton (previously known as PHE) by taxi and Salisbury railway station is about 20 minutes by taxi.

### **On arrival**

On arrival at the Porton site, please turn onto Manor Farm Road and at the top of the rise, turn left onto the site. You should report to the Gatehouse, where you will be asked to sign the visitors book and issued with an identity pass. You will then be given directions and your host contacted. On arrival at the main building entrance, you should report to reception, where you will be collected by your host. Please note that visitors are to be escorted at all times.
